Librarian's Report: Memorials are up to date. We are down in statistic numbers because of the closure due to the step construction. An update on the Lego project: we can apply for the ME Library Fund grant by November. Lois has been gathering prices on bricks, books etc. so she can apply. It is a simple grant. Also United Way may give 24 single Lego sets. The lady who heads up United Way will help us look for someone to run the program. There is also another grant in the spring for \$2500. Storage is also needed. We now have an Amazon credit card (through the town) for the Library. We can use it for the Nook.

New Business: There is a hornet problem downstairs, but Adam has put a hornet trap in the ceiling. Hopefully it will do the trick. There is also a crack and a leak near the mural downstairs. Could it be from the new construction? The Trunk or Treat proceeds are coming to the library. We should have a trunk pertaining to the library. Laurie volunteered to do it.

Laurie will make the changes to the by-laws concerning fines.

We need to have goals about promoting the library to the community. We need to address attendance at the board meetings. We need help with the bookstore...maybe Monday nights? Once a month. We need a sign for outside of library for the bookstore. Charlotte moved to buy a portable sign for outside up to \$200. Heidi seconded. Motion carried.

Lois will put the information in the Star Herald for Toddler Time, Book Club etc. She will also send it to County Calendar. Adam asked about furnace cleaning. We will wait until next year.

Dues for the internet for this fiscal year will not be charged. Next meeting is Thursday, November 8<sup>th</sup> at 5:00. Meeting adjourned at 6:10.
