### Washburn Memorial Library

#### **Board of Trustees Meeting**

#### August 4, 2015

Members in attendance: Linda Bourgoine, Rita Kingsbury, Christina Maynard, Warrena Forbes, Heidi Silver, and Lois Walton

John Kelly, mason from Bridgewater, shared the following assessment of our porch, steps and ramp. The door swing is a liability because one cannot be on the platform, open the door and have room enough to enter around the door with a wheelchair. The platform should extend out to where the second step is now. There could be more steps and it would be nice to extend the concrete to the street. John recommends a white more esthetic balustrade style of railing instead of what the Caribou library has. He suggests that we remove all the soft concrete and remove the broken steps. He also recommends pouring a new pad for a ramp rather than extending the existing ramp. He also recommends smooth finish (broom finish) 4,000 lb. concrete that is impervious to water. SW Collins carries the railing John recommends; it's guaranteed for 50 years. John agreed to make arrangements with both Caribou and Presque Isle SW Collins to show any board members what he is describing. John does not have any numbers together yet as he considers this to be a preliminary meeting with the board. John emphasized that the safety issues are most important at this time. John reports that the work would be done in two stages: steps and platform first with an overall time of two weeks. He chooses work times that accommodate the open hours of the library and causes as little disruption as possible. He details well and the job will be complete when he is finished. John mentioned the Rural Development (USDA) and Next Generation grants received by WTA Hansen Memorial Library for the work he completed there and mentioned that Ryan Shaw could help us with details about those grants. That library received a 30% rebate on their installation of new lighting. John again mentioned his preference for the balustrade type of railing and posts for quality, esthetics and soundness of structure.

John's presentation was followed by a discussion of the Randall Fund and possible grants. We want something that lasts. We hope to have a bid from John at our next meeting.

#### Secretary's Report:

Lois passed out minutes of the June 2, 2015 meeting. Rita moved to accept and Christina seconded.

#### Financial Report:

We should be at about 50% of our budgeted amount and we are a little bit over that. Lois reported that it may be because she has been buying books. Lois also reported that Adam Doody has reported that our book drop is on its last legs. We are at the end of being able to repair it. New ones are priced at about \$2,000. Christina made a motion to accept the Financial Report as read and her move was seconded by Warrena.

#### Librarian's Report:

Lois's report included two months of data. It shows big jumps in July which Lois believes were caused by her summer reading program. Next Monday is the last night of the summer reading program. Children have enjoyed the program and Janet has come in to cover the library while Lois is working with the

children. Lois reports that over 600 Washburn residents used Maine Info Net last year. The number of books checked out of the library is up sharply over earlier months.

Lois' father, Erwin Flewelling, will be here in the basement on the 15<sup>th</sup> for August Fest. He's a carver of birds and will demonstrate and have birds to sell. Help is needed to move furniture to set up for him and we might need to get more chairs from the Town Office building. Help at 4:30 would be greatly appreciated. Lois is assuming that Debbie Hoyt will not be doing a quilt show in the library for August Fest.

Bev and Liana Kingsbury are still working out the paper work for the contribution to Maine Community Foundation.

Our next meeting will be September 1 at 5 o'clock.

Christina motioned to adjourn and Heidi seconded. Motion carried.
